**Extracted from Rates & Charges Summary Notes (9-12-16)**

The TCD Board of Supervisor's took the following actions at the 9-12-16 Rates & Charges Work Session, in order to meet the deadline for submission of Resolutions for the Southwest Area Meeting (SWAM).


**Consideration of WACD Resolutions, All**

- Doug Rushton presented two draft motions to serve as foundation for resolutions to submit at the SWAM: (draft/incomplete language)
  - 1) Drop population criteria to allow any CD to pursue a Rates & Charges cap at \$15.00 per parcel
  - 2) ...Streamline public disclosure process to draw line between reasonable and unreasonable public records request.

**Doug moved to adopt two draft WACD resolutions, one related to Rates & Charges population criteria and one related to streamlining public disclosure request to discern between reasonable and unreasonable requests. Aslan seconded. Discussion: Has there been movement elsewhere in country on clarifying these issues? Yes, can't speak to what they are; We should check language and success stories; WACD will do this research and set the parameters for what is reasonable and unreasonable. Vote: Doug & Aslan in favor; Richard & Eric abstained.**

**Amendment to split into two motions. First motion: WACD to work with conservation districts, state Conservation Commission, others, and the legislature to make changes to Chapter 89.08 RCW to drop the population criteria in section 405(3)(a) to allow districts to have the option of a rate of up to \$15. Vote: All in favor. Motion passes. Second motion: WACD to work with conservation districts, state Conservation Commission, others, and the legislature to streamline the public disclosure request (PDR) process distinguishing between reasonable and unreasonable requests. The second motion died.**
